What are the Projects?

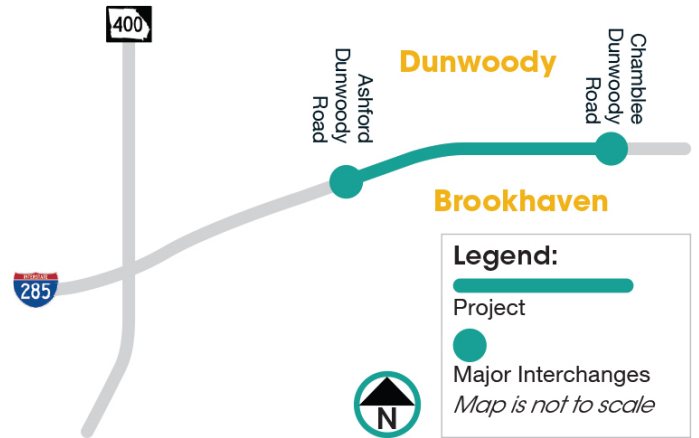
- 1. I-285 Westbound Collector-Distributor Lanes (PI # 0017125):** Would extend the collector-distributor (CD) lanes constructed under the Transform 285/400 Interchange Improvement project from I-285 westbound between Chamblee Dunwoody Road and Ashford Dunwoody Road to expand the CD system in this area. This would alleviate existing traffic congestion and allow better maintenance of traffic during future construction of express lanes.
- 2. I-285/Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Interchange Improvements (PI # 0017126):** Would consolidate the I-285 westbound exit ramps to Peachtree Industrial Boulevard northbound and southbound and would improve the horizontal curve of the northbound exit ramp which would reduce the bottleneck from I-285 to Peachtree Industrial Boulevard northbound.
- 3. I-285 Westbound Auxiliary Lane Extension (PI # 0017130):** Would extend the auxiliary lane and reconstructs the Mount Vernon Highway Bridge over I-285, providing relief between Transform 285/400 Interchange Improvement project construction and I-285 Top End West Express Lanes construction. These improvements also would allow better maintenance of traffic during the construction of the future express lanes.

5 Things You Need to Know

1. Advancing the design for these projects provides opportunities to implement some Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP) project components early
2. These projects are being constructed separate of the express lanes' projects
3. These projects would facilitate local road improvements
4. These advancements would help maintain traffic flow and minimize construction impacts during the larger express lanes project construction
5. Early delivery would minimize schedule impacts to accommodate future express lanes

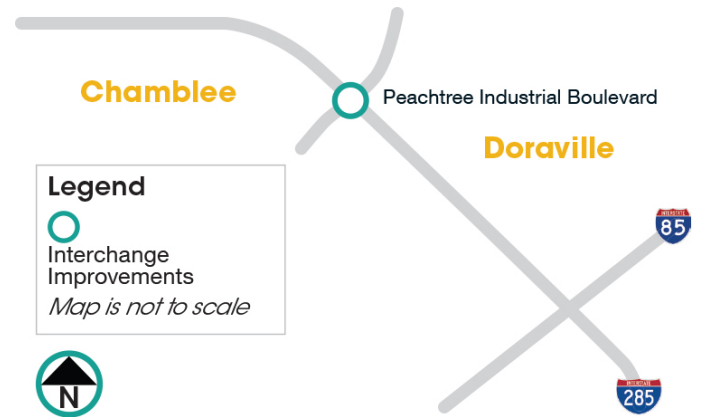

Between Chamblee Dunwoody Road and Ashford Dunwoody Road



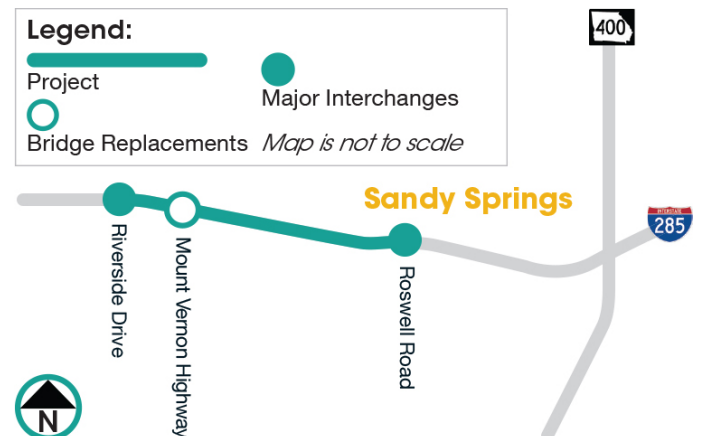
- 2. I-285/Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Interchange Improvements**

What's the Status?

Environmental documents are expected to be approved by December 2020 for the I-285 Peachtree Industrial Boulevard Improvements and I-285 Westbound Collector-Distributor Lanes. The environmental document for I-285 Westbound Auxiliary Lane Extension is expected to be approved by April 2022. All environmental documents would be available for viewing online at <https://majormobilityga.com>, or at the Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) Office of Environmental Services. Procurement for the first of the I-285 Advanced Improvement Projects would begin by July 2020.
